

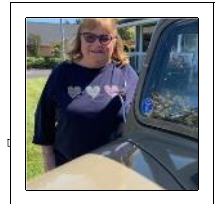

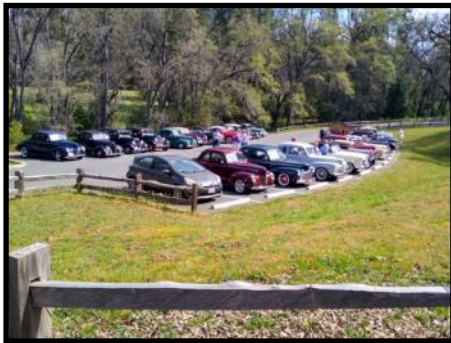
BLACK BART 50TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

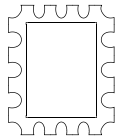
